S E R M O N

Compassion

Compassion is defined as the deep awareness of the suffering of others. Literally it means that you suffer with them. I read passages like Matthew 9 and become keenly aware of Christ's compassion for the world. If you are anything like me, we are happy to receive His compassion and grateful He has compassion on us. *We have all been sheep without a shepherd and deserved God's wrath rather than His compassion.* Today it seems we spend a lot of time talking about the Gospel and how it saves and has saved us. Jesus didn't just talk about the Gospel—He lived out the Gospel and demonstrated the Gospel through His Compassion on the lost. **We must also recognize if we claim to be His, then we must have compassion on the lost as well.** We should be motivated by Christ's compassion to serve Him with Compassion. If so, what does that look like? I propose to you that the Christian character trait of compassion looks like Jesus!

MARK 9:35-38 NKJV

I. Jesus compassion was unlimited. (Mark 9:35)

- He went to all places.
- He preached the Gospel to all people.
- He healed all people.

II. Jesus had compassion on the Lost. (Mark 9:36-37)

- He recognized the value of the multitudes. (Mark 9:36-37)
- He recognized the enormity of the work. (Mark 9:36-37)
- He recognized the suffering of the multitudes. (Mark 9:36)
 - They had no direction.
 - They had no protection.
 - They had no provision.
 - They didn't belong.
 - Neither did we.
- The Workers are often few because compassion is lacking. (Mark 9:37)

III. We need to pray that the workers would recognize the command and the example of Jesus. (Mark 9:38)

- He ignored racial and gender divisions. (John 4)
- His compassion included those that hated him. (Matthew 23:37-39)
- His compassion was demonstrated with sacrifice. (Luke 23:46)
