# S E R M O N

## *The Cure for a Community in Distress*

It is inevitable there will be challenges to unity within the Body of Christ. Christians must ask themselves how can I be a peacemaker? Peacemakers are described as being the Sons of God and blessed by Him—so how can I meet the challenges the World and the enemy bring to the Body of Christ? How can I prepare myself personally to be a unifying force within the community of believers I am a part of? James gives us ten practical steps to follow if we want to bring peace to a community in distress.

### JAMES 4:7-10

#### I. We have to remember who's in charge. *(James 4:7)*

- a) We have to submit to God.
- b) We have to resist the devil.

#### II. We have to recognize our needs and our failures. *(James 4:8)*

- a) Draw near to God.
- b) We need to cleanse our hands.
- c) We need to purify our hearts.

#### III. We have to realize our attitude affects our community. *(James 4:9-10)*

- a) We should be miserable.
- b) We should mourn.
- c) We should weep.
- d) We should be serious.
- e) We should be Humble.

#### IV. Without these things, we should question who we belong to. *(James 5:19-20)*

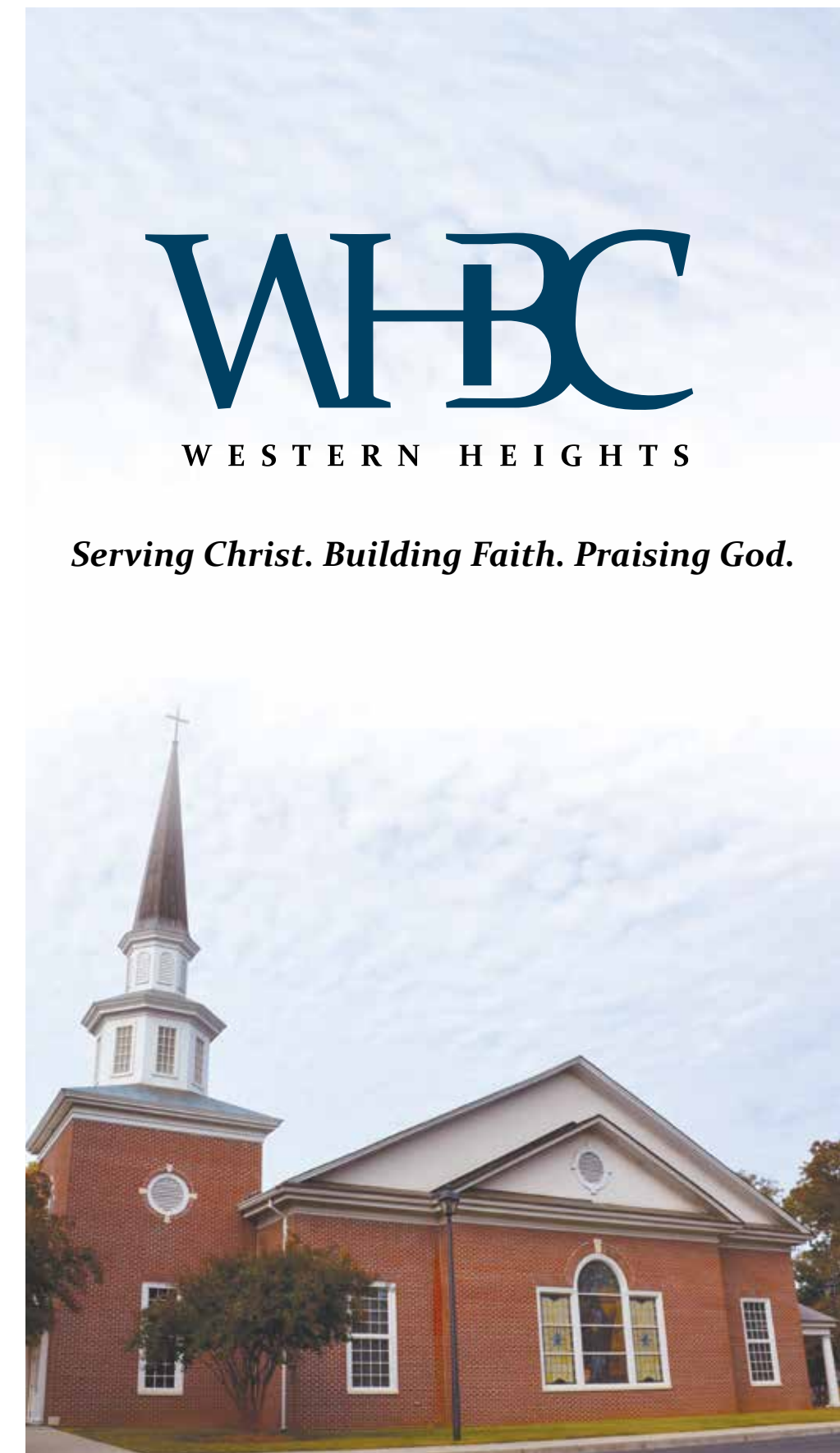
