It's hard to fathom that the all-powerful God of the Universe would see fit to allow us to choose Him or to deny Him. Of course God could make us all bow the knee. Upon His return every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that He is Lord. However, in the interim He allows us to have free will and determine how we will respond to His calling and purpose for our lives. Scripture makes it clear that everyone will not use their free will to respond to his loving invitation and surrender to His Grace. In fact, it points out many instances in which individuals hear clearly God's message for them and yet they "harden their hearts". To harden the heart means to simply reject the message that God has delivered to you. The Bible warns against hardening your heart. Hebrews says repeatedly that we are not to harden our hearts as in the days of the rebellion. Also, everyone who hardens their heart to the Lord in the Bible then endures God's judgment in some manner. In Ezekiel 36:26 God shows His desire to remove our hardened hearts and to replace them with a heart of flesh. Perhaps it's been a while since you have felt the Lord truly move in your heart? Is it possible that somewhere along the line you decided to ignore His direction and then over time you have lost your sensitivity to the Holy Spirit entirely? While it is possible for that to happen the greater question is what to do about it? If God is pricking your heart through this article and revealing to you something that He has wanted changed in your life don't wait, simply respond in obedience. Don't give your heart a chance to become atrophied again but rather repent and use this opportunity to be restored to fellowship with the Savior. Let God give you a heart of flesh again that you might experience not only His love but the love of and for those around you.
