

Youth Notes

Over the last several months, WHBC students have been challenged not only to know *what* they believe, but *why* they believe it. The question of why is a much harder question to answer, but it is one that unbelievers are asking in today's world. 1 Peter 3:15 commands believers to "always be ready to give a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you." We want to be people who know the truth we believe in, but also people who are able to share that truth convincingly with others. Outsiders of the Christian faith no longer believe that the church has the correct answers about life, salvation, and eternity. Instead, the world is increasingly skeptical of any "religious" institution and as a result they approach believers with many tough questions.

What would you say to someone who asked you "How do you know that God exists" or "Why should I trust the Bible over holy books from other religions" or yet "why would a merciful and good God allow people to suffer?" These are questions that the world is asking of the Christian faith, and we are the people they seek out for answers. Do we believe that there are good answers to these questions? Absolutely Yes! However, they are not simple or easy. Being able to "defend" your faith (or tell someone why you believe what you believe) not only helps you answer the questions of others, but it actually strengthens your faith along the way. When someone asks us a question we do not know the answer to, it can temporarily cause us to question our faith. Yet, as we pursue the answers to these questions we grow stronger in the Lord and are more convinced that His Word is true and we can trust Him.

For a good starting point with some of these questions, I would recommend a couple of books to you, both by author Alex McFarland. "The 10 Most Common Objections to Christianity" explores 10 difficult questions about the Christian faith and answers them briefly but powerfully. For parents of children or teens, "The 21 Toughest Questions Your Kids will Ask about Christianity: And How to Answer them Confidently" provides important answers that children need as they grow in the Lord. I have several copies of each book in my office for anyone who would like delve a little deeper.
